THE WORLD BANK MEETING WITH SSC CEOs

World Bank Meeting with SSC CEOs was held on 18 March 2016 at Taj Man Singh- Longchamp Hall, New Delhi. CEO, SSSDC was in attendance for the same. World Bank apprised first-hand about the project that they are working upon a proposed \$1 Billion Project for supporting the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Govt. of India on its program Skills Training for Employability Leveraging Public Partnership Operation (STEPPPP). The project will support the newly formed National Skill Development Mission (NSDM) for strengthening the following components:-

- Strengthening the NSDM and its institutions like the (i) NSDA as the regulatory and quality assurance body to put in place the qualifications framework at all levels (ii) the NSDC, the arm for promoting Private Sector participation in training delivery, and its 40 Sector Skills Councils (SSCs) have been set up under NSDC to ensure employer led and demand-driver training programs.

- The project will further support all the states through the State Skills Development Missions (SSDMs) for providing market oriented trainings.
- The Government will engage in a public- private partnership (PPP) arrangement to create a Skills Fund that would pool together Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds and other private financial resources for skilling interventions through innovative private sector led skilling efforts.

The program will have special focus on job creation for disadvantaged sections especially SC, ST, women with disaggregated focus on the low income states of India (Bihar, Jharkhand, Rajasthan, MP, Chhattisgarh, Orissa, UP).

All the SSCs leaders gave their inputs on how the SSCs could be strengthened in the role they are currently entrusted with, how the role of SSCs could sync with the States, how could SSCs support international migration of work force and support create qualified trainers and assessors, create industry connect so hence and so forth.
