NATIONAL CONFERENCE: SAFE CITIES



On 13 April 2015, the Chairman and CEO attended the “National Conference” on Safe Cities organised by ASSOCHAM, with CAPSI as one of the associated partners. Shri Kiren Rijiju, Minister of State Home graced the occasion.

The Chairman addressed the conference about the importance of Security in “Safe & Smart Cities” concept. He emphasised on the need for trained and certified Security Personnel as per the National Occupational Standards through SSSDC. The message was well taken by the audience.

MEETING NSDC

On 10 April 2015 the CEO, COO and Principal (T&D) attended a “one on one” meeting with NSDC officials at their premises on various issues related to implementation of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY). A number of related issues were deliberated based on past experience of STAR Scheme and the nuances of the ensuing scheme. The meeting was highly fruitful.

VISIT TO TRIPURA

On 24 April 2015, Col Rathore attended the Skill Development Conference at the State Secretariat of Govt of Tripura at Agartala – Tripura. It was chaired by Mr. YP Singh, Chief Secretary - Government of Tripura and attended by all Secretaries and Mr. Jaikant and Ms. Sapna Poti from NSDC, two SSCs and a large number of VTPs. Tripura has some ongoing skilling projects mainly in the field of Agriculture, Horticulture, Forestry and Fishery with the help of Japan and Germany. In their State Livelihood Mission, Security does not figure. Chief Secretary informed that there are about 6.5 lac unemployed youth in the state and finding jobs for them is Government’s priority. He welcomed all VTPs and reiterated that in Government’s schemes placement is a must. No roadmap exists with the Govt of Tripura, as of now.

He was impressed with their training lab in particular.

On 29 April 2015, CEO visited the training institute and interacted with functionaries at all levels. He found that Terrier is a well laid out and well administered training institute, not only in Karnataka, but pan India.

MEETING: SCERT

On 27 April 2015, Col U S Rathore attended a meeting at SCERT. The agenda was NSQF and other problems associated with curriculum, syllabus, training and assessment. Mr. B R Kharbas, NSQF in charge of Dept. of Education, Haryana chaired the meeting. Besides him, reps of NSDC, SSSC, CII, Training Providers, Assessment Bodies and Vocational Training Teachers attended the meeting. It was well attended forum. Following issues were discussed:-

- a) Review of curriculum and course material as per NSQF levels.
- b) Method of assessment and quality of assessment of vocational training at schools.
- c) Requirement of sending a feedback on quality of assessment from school principal to dept of education.
- d) Assessment bodies raised a point regarding absenteeism during assessment.
- e) Vocational training teachers raised an issue of difficulty in getting industry visit and on-the-job-training of students due to non-cooperation from industry.
- f) Insufficient number of students at some schools to make assessment viable.

AUDIT OF TPs

During the month, the nominated "Audit Team" of SSSDC carried out audit of 37 TPs in Delhi and Hyderabad.

MEETING WITH GSA INTERNATIONAL.



On 29 April 2015, a delegation of GSA International headed by Gary Weisengreen, CEO called on the Chairman and made a presentation to the SSSDC in presence of COO, Manager ENTP and 3 reps from GSA. They showed keen interest in mutual Security related ventures in India and abroad. The Chairman appraised the guest delegation about the prevalent security and safety scenario and security related business prospects in future with regards to **Smart Cities**. It was mutually decided to take forward the dialogue/interaction to the next level.

VISIT TO BANGALORE.

On 28 April 2015, a visit was undertaken by CEO at the request of President CAPSI and President Karnataka Security Agencies Association to commemorate their 25 Years Anniversary, combined with periodical CAPSI Chapter meeting. The meeting was attended by two Ministers of Karnataka Govt (Labour and Transport) and Controlling Authority (Shri Amar Pandey, IPS) amongst various other distinguished personalities. It was a good opportunity to interact with the Controlling Authority, who understood the point of view of SSSDC well and commented that the eco system of SSSDC (NOS / NSQF based training and certification) would be suitably analysed and incorporated. He also requested CEO to visit Bangalore again for detailed deliberations. During the meeting, he addressed the gathering, which was well taken by all.

VISIT TO CHENNAI.

The visit was undertaken by CEO at the request of Capt Shibu Issac, Chairman CAPSI Chapter (Tamil Nadu and Puducherry), for the Chapter Meeting. Besides others, the rep of Controlling Authority (Training), Mr. Dixit, IPS was also present. CEO addressed the gathering and emphasized on the need to incorporate the SSSDC Eco-system towards improving quality and bringing in standardization. It was heartening to learn that the TN State has already started recognizing SSSDC affiliated TPs and has already issued training licences to four TPs on the basis of their affiliation with SSSDC, after carrying out inspections – this aspect is also connected with the MHA letter to all Controlling Authorities. The Controlling Authority was highly appreciative of SSSDC efforts and eco system in bringing in quality and agreed to adopt the same in TN in totality. This is indeed a landmark achievement.
