6	ABOUT THE EVENT/ ACTIVITY (in max 200 words)	<p>CEO attended the Second meeting of the Board of Studies held on 04 March 2017 at Bhartiya Skill Development University Campus, Jaipur. The Chairman of the Board informed the members of an MOU signed between GOR and BSDU making it to be the Proper First Ever Skill University in India. He briefed that the students can get admitted in the B.Voc course after obtaining NSQF level 4 from the schools. Level 5 is the present Polytechnic diploma level and Level 6 and Level 7 are Under Graduate levels called as B.Voc. Level 8</p>

and Level 9 are Post Graduate and Level 10 is equivalent to Ph.D. At all the levels, the students are expected to meet descriptors of respective levels of NSQF.

The chairperson informed the BOS that work on alignment of the B.Voc programs with the QPs-NOS has already started in the university after the 1<sup>st</sup> BOS meeting.

The chairperson also informed that the university is organizing a seminar towards the end of March 2017 for the industry experts to provide them detailed information about B.Voc course structure, Swiss Dual system, BSDU vision and mission so as to facilitate University-Industry MOUs for internship.

The BOS members agreed to provide full support to BSDU team in detailing the syllabus/QPs of their respective domains.

The meeting concluded after scheduling 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2017 for 3<sup>rd</sup> BOS meeting.

6	ABOUT THE EVENT/ ACTIVITY (in max 200 words)	<p><b><u>RMSA, RAJASTHAN :</u></b></p> <p>Meeting of Rajasthan Board was attended by Manager Projects at Jaipur to discuss the responsibilities, deadlines and method of conducting the assessments in Rajasthan under NSQF.</p> <p>On behalf of Security sector, Manager Projects gave her inputs about disparity in the number of students, accuracy in school details, trainers to be trained and certified under SSSDC, very short notice in sharing the school data to SSC, clarity in sending the assessment documents to the board or to the state, delay in payments.</p> <p>It was assured by the board and the state that the school data will be shared well in advance as the details are uploaded on their portal and the rest of the issues will be dealt with at earliest.</p>

		<p><b><u>RSLDC, RAJASTHAN :</u></b></p> <p>Manager Projects, SSSDC met Mr. Pradeep Kumar Sharma, DGM, Mr. Naveen Sharma and Mr. Rahul Kumar on various issues including the delay in payments. It was told that the payment had already been processed and the file is with the MD, for final release of payments.</p> <p>Increase in assessment fees was also discussed to which Mr. Pradeep assured that it is being looked into and will be revised w.e.f. 01 March 2017 as per the common norms, a communication will be sent by them to all the SSCs. The existing MOU which is still valid till October 2017 will be renewed and shared nearer to the date.</p> <p>It was brought to our notice that the assessments conducted in Rajasthan for many batches on more than one day is becoming costly as RSLDC has to depute the District Coordinators to the respective training centers during the assessments to check on the same. It was requested by the state skill mission to complete the assessments for more than one batch in one day itself to avoid the travel cost being incurred by them.</p> <p>A new portal is being introduced by RSLDC for which the process would be different and will be shared with the council shortly.</p>
